Ayr & Kilwinning

Ayr and Kilwinning Free church is found on the south west coast of Scotland. The population of Ayr is about 48 000 people and that of Kilwinning about 21 000. The congregation is a linked charge between what were the two separate congregations of Ayr Free church and Kilwinning Free church. The congregation is served by the minister Rev Rory Stott and five other elders and a community worker in Kilwinning, Mrs Gillian Moyo. Gillian works closely with SU Scotland and with their help has run holiday clubs over the last two summers and she has also brought the Bible Alive program to local primary schools in Kilwinning.

Prayer Points

- 1. Both sides of the congregation have significant challenges concerning their places of worship: please pray for solutions concerning the impractical layout of the church building in Ayr and for a suitable, long term place to worship in Kilwinning.
- The congregation in Kilwinning have benefited for some time now from various preachers preaching on Sundays, however more of a consistent ministry is sought now. Please pray for someone to come and lead the work in Kilwinning, who will not only be able to preach but build relationships in the community as well.

Helmsdale and Kinbrace

Helmsdale is a small village in the east of Sutherland. There are about 750 people living in the village and the surrounding area. The congregation has seen a slow growth in the last 4 plus years, and we can have over 40 in attendance in our morning service, but the regular number is about 35.

Prayer Points

- 1. In the last few months, we have seen a rise in ministry directed to women. Between meals and testimony to their own bible study. We are greatly encouraged to see the amount of people being reached and give thanks for the discipleship going on through the bible studies. We have also seen some New Birth as well which we are delighted about.
- 2. We have seen a rise in men and some young men coming into the congregation. We are delighted that they are keen to follow Jesus and learn to be better disciples. But we need to see more men willing to become leaders and bring their gifts into the life of the body of Christ here
