On Friday 18th October at 7.30pm, there will be special meeting in the Rev M A Macleod Memorial Hall, Kenneth Street, to mark the 40th anniversary of the Dumisani Theological Institute & Bible School in Southern Africa. The speaker will be Dr Jack C Whytock, Visiting Principal at the institute and his theme will be 'The Vital Importance of the Bible School Movement in Missions'. A book marking the anniversary Voices of Thanksgiving will be available on the evening. Dumisani is the official theological training institute of the Free Church in Southern Africa. The Free Church in the Western Isles has always maintained a supportive interest in the missionary movement in Southern Africa. We are a small, united congregation, with about forty people attending our morning service, and fifteen at the evening one. We are thankful to have a good mix of ages and people from a wide variety of backgrounds. The church is located in one of the poorest areas in Fife. We have a positive reputation in the local community, after years of serving through various forms of community work.

#### **Prayer Points:**

- We long to be a sustainable church which requires growth and so please pray that the Lord would send us many new gospel-hearted individuals and families to help us in our work. Also, pray that we might see conversions and that our members would grow stronger in the way they intentionally develop relationships with unbelievers at home, work and in the community, and that they would share their lives and the gospel with them.
