Dunblane

Dunblane Free Church was planted by Cumbernauld Free Church and had its first minister in 1985. It is situated right at the heart of Dunblane just off the High Street. A new minister, Allan Shearer, was inducted on 5th October 2019 and we are all looking to our great God for the future.

Prayer Points:

- 1. Pray for wisdom for the elders and deacons as they lead the congregation and that the Lord would glorify Himself in our midst. We want to be following His plans for Dunblane.
- 2. Pray that each member would become more like the Lord Jesus Christ day by day and be salt and light in Dunblane as we seek to grow and make Jesus known. Pray that we might see conversions with people coming to faith in Christ.

Plockton and Kyle

Serving a population of about 1,500 in peninsular Lochalsh, there are about 60 people regularly worshipping in the Plockton and Kyle congregation. Several other evangelical congregations worship in the area, and we seek to have a good relationship with them. We are nearing completion of a refurbishment of the Kyle building. The minister has been serving the congregation for the last 30 years.

Prayer Points:

- 1. On Remembrance Sunday 4 local congregations will come together to seek gospel hope in a world at war. We hope to have put a Remembrance Day tract and invitation around the Kyle area. Pray for a good response.
- 2. Pray for a Christianity Explored group meeting in November and for God to draw new families and potential leaders into the congregation. Thank you.



Sun 10th East Asia

Pray for our brothers and sisters in East Asia who are affected by the ongoing tightening of restrictions on the church. Draft regulations on religious content online have just been published for public comment – this would make it illegal to disseminate text, audio or video material online without a special permit. (It applies to all religions, including Islam and Buddhism, not just Christianity). The church Catriona's friend Helen attends has been shut down, so people are meeting in small groups. Pray for joy, courage, and wisdom for our brothers and sisters there.

Mon 11th SA

Continue to pray that another short term lecturer of seven weeks can be found for terms two or three at Dumisani in 2020 for our certificate/diploma programmes. May the Lord raise up such a lecturer for one term next year.

Tues 12th Peru

Give thanks Catriona has a new tenant for her flat in Glasgow. Pray God would continue to abundantly supply all her needs.

Wed 13th Japan

A number of churches in Japan were badly damaged by the recent typhoon. Pray for the recovery and restoration and that the local church's efforts to the victims of that typhoon would be blessed.

Thurs 14th CWI

Please pray for CWI missionary Bogi Kozma as she continues to reach out to Jewish people in Hungary. Give thanks for God's grace in the life of Sonja, a Jewish Holocaust survivor who recently went to be with Lord. Having been led to faith two years ago by Bogi, she had learnt to look for the good things from God and be thankful for his provision by reading Philippians 4:4-7 'With thanksgiving, let your requests be known to God, and the peace of God...will guard your hearts...'

Fri 15th Emmaus Road Trust

Pray for meetings being held in Dhaka and Chittagong between the 18th and 23rd to explore ways of supporting Christian publishing and writing. The Bengali people are described in Operation World as the largest unreached people group in the world. There is certainly very little publishing going on. Pray that God would open the floodgates.

Sat 16th WEC

Please pray for the student ministry teams at the college. They consist of 5-6 people involved in various things outside of Cornerstone (kids club, international café, working with refugees, ladies' prison, toddler group and several others). Pray for Donald as he supervises a team that visits a men's
