Glasgow City

Glasgow City Free Church is located in the business quarter of the city centre and is a gathered church with members coming from a scattered area within and out with the city. It has a wide age spread with most worshippers falling within the 16 to 54 age range. There is a creche, Sunday School and Bible Class. The congregation attracts students from Scotland and overseas. Small Groups meet regularly in different homes. Tourists (curious to view the interior church architecture) along with workers from nearby businesses are invited to a 15-minute service every Tuesday.
