Full Registration:

I will **NOT** sell a puppy on full registration if:

- "I only want to breed it once so I can give puppies to my friends and family"
- It is under 6 weeks of age when you want to choose. (There isn't a way to tell if a puppy is a good breeding prospect any earlier than that. Conformation is KEY!)
- "I really want my children to learn about birthing and raising puppies"
- If "color" is the main reason for breeding.
- "I want to breed my dog to this dog to get a prospective service animal"

Requirements IF Approved for Full Registration:

- Health testing done prior to breeding.
- Two breeding references and a vet reference MUST be provided.
- Pictures of your breeding facility, other dogs, and yard MUST be sent via email or text.
- If the puppy isn't going to be shown whether Internationally, AKC, or UKC, full registration will not be approved.
- If you purchase a puppy on Full Registration with the intent to show and do not, the AKC papers will remain in my name. Once CH title is earned I will transfer papers fully over to you.
- GCD will always be listed as an owner on the registration certificate until CH title is received.
- Any studs used on the bitch must be mutually agreed upon by the buyer and the seller.
- Any bitches the stud is to be used on, must be mutually agreed upon by the buyer and seller.

Any puppy that is sold on full, please be prepared to stay in touch with me. I have absolutely no problem mentoring you or helping you in any way I can. I need to make sure that my puppies are being taken care of properly, especially during the breeding process. If this isn't something you are interested in, then I am not the breeder for you.

Even though I have full registration as an option it does not mean I will sell a puppy on full. I have only sold TWO puppies on full. Both met the standard. Both were conformed to the standard and both would preserve the breed.
