Group Activities Include: *(must have 20 or more to make up each group)*

- Transportation via Deluxe Minibus & Natchez Hop-on Hop-off bus
- The Natchez Visitor Center
- Grand Village of the Natchez Indians
 - View trails and participate in a class on Arrowheads and Native American tools
- Swimming at the “House on Ellicott Hill” each afternoon before pick up
- Tour of Longwood
- Historic Jefferson College & Trails
- Natchez Trace: Emerald Mound, Mount Locust
- Tour of Downtown Natchez on the Hop-on Hop-off bus
- Walk the Natchez Trails along the bluff
- The William Johnson House – “The Barber of Natchez”
- Memorial Park: See the Veteran’s Monument, the Fountain, and the Cannon with a Scavenger Hunt
- Meals included are 2 snacks per day, Box Lunch, juices and water
- Natchez Bag and daily handouts

**** Certified Lifeguards** will be at the House on Ellicott Hill Pool. Swimming Test will be required on Monday for swimming in the deep. However, assistance will be given to those that need it.

9:00 am - Tour the Natchez Visitor Reception Center exhibits; and view The Natchez Story

10:00 am - Arrive at the Grand Village of the Natchez Indians for a special presentation on arrowheads and the Natchez Indians

12:00 pm - Box Lunch at the Grand Village

Walk the Trails at the Grand Village and learn a few Natchez Indian Games

2:00 pm - Depart for swimming at “House on Ellicott Hill”

5:00 pm - Pick up House on Ellicott Hill

8:30 am – Meet at **Rolling River Bistro** and board Minibus

9:00 am - Tour Longwood & Walk to Cemetery on the Grounds

10:45 am - Tour Historic Jefferson College and walk the Trails

12:00 pm - Go to Natchez Trace and have box Lunch at Mount Locus

1:00 pm - Tour Emerald Mound - other sites on the Natchez Trace; and look for arrowheads

3:00 pm – House on Ellicott Hill Swimming

9:00 am - Walk to William Johnson House, “The Barber of Natchez”

10:30 am - Snack on The Bluffs at Fort Rosalie

12:30 pm - Hop on – Hop off Tour of Natchez

- Drop off at Memorial Park for Scavenger Hunt – Learn about the Fountain, the Veterans Memorial and other monuments in the park
