The goal of this clinic is to provide you as a coach, the basic tools you need to effectively train your archers to be competitive in your programs. We do discuss all the disciplines used in 4-H (sighted recurve, barebow, Genesis, and compound). The cost of the program includes two instruction manuals and a training tool.

This clinic is also a USA Archery Level 2 certification course for those who are interested in getting nationally certified, for more information on the Level 2 certification process please refer to the next page. **NOTE: YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO GET CERTIFIED!**

USAA Level 2 Certification Information



This class is also an official Level 2 Certification Class recognized by USAA, NFAA and ASA archery associations. Thus you have the opportunity (if you wish) to become a certified archery instructor with these associations. **This is not a requirement to participate in the class!**

There are additional benefits to obtaining a Level 2 Certification and they are:

1. To be able to start and to be the lead instructor for a USA Archery sanctioned archery club. There are three types of sanctioned clubs and they are JOAD (Junior Olympic Archery Development), Adult Archery Program, and Collegiate Archery Program clubs.
2. To be able to run a Level One Certification course. So if you start a club, you will be able to get your assistant coaches certified to help.
3. To be able to run an Explore Archery program
4. Eligible for additional liability insurance from USA Archery.
5. You are also eligible to attend the USA Archery Coaches Symposiums.

Requirements to receive certification for level two are:

1. Must be 18 years old.
2. Must be an active member of USAA, NFAA or ASA.
3. Must go through a background check through USA Archery.
4. Must have completed the Safesport program.

Please note that you DO NOT need a Level One Certification to get certified as a Level 2 Instructor. Study information will be sent to all participants prior to the class.
