

## **JUSTICE FOR MARKEIS MCGLOCKTON**


#### IN THIS ISSUE:

On Saturday, August 24, the family of Markeis McGlockton, their attorneys, and the community gathered at Mt. Zion to respond to the guilty verdict of Michael Drejka. There were many emotions in the room that day, but most importantly there was a sense of relief. "It's been well over a year since we've been dealing with this matter, and I



can safely say my family can rest now," McGlockton's father, Michael McGlockton said.

The trial lasted a week and the jury deliberated late into the evening for six hours on the last day. Community supporters and clergy were in the courtroom that week to stand in support of the McGlockton family. Among them was our pastor, Rev. Lee Hall-Perkins.

Ben Crump, attorney for Britany Jacobs, encouraged the community to continue to stand with the family, especially as Britany will have to raise three children without their father. Sentencing for Drejka will take place on September 10.

# MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN SCHOOLS

Sandy Lane Elementary is Mt. Zion's adopted school. Each week we have volunteers who go there to have lunch with students, mentor them, help teachers in the classroom, and even proctor tests at end of the school year.

Rowland Johnson, is one of our dedicated volunteers who gives his time at Sandy Lane and Kings Highway Elementary Magnet School. He mentors PJ, who last year, lost his mother. Rowland was right there with PJ when he was needed the most and continues to this day. Through this mentoring relationship, Mt. Zion was also able to support PJ and his family. During a Sunday worship service, we wrote notes of encouragement. We collected school clothes for PJ and connected his family with community resources in addition to the ones Rowland had already found.

PJ's story is a testimony to why it is so important for us as a church to be present and active in our local schools.

Pastor Lee will begin volunteering each week this school year at Sandy Lane and invites others to join him and our other volunteers. Volunteer applications are available on the welcome desk in the worship center lobby or you can request one from the church's secretary (kgrollinger@mzumc.net)

You can volunteer to be a tutor, classroom assistant, reader, or lunch pal. Lunch Pals is a lunch time mentoring program where businesses, community organizations, and individuals are paired with a student to provide additional presence of caring adults.

Sandy Lane is a Title 1 school and has received a grade of D for the third year in a row from the Florida Department of Education, but we believe the teachers and students can and will succeed.
