Uncommon Touch

How it all began....

Did you know that Uncommon Touch Ministries is 23 years old? It started in 1993 when a man came to the church while Ms. Betty Perry was there and said he was hungry. When he came back the next week he brought a friend... And so it began!

From the very beginning Uncommon Touch Ministries (UTM) was fully funded by Ms. Betty and sometimes other believers.

Through Ms. Betty's tireless efforts and dedication, UTM is a 501(c) (3) organization which means we can apply for and accept grants and donations with a tax exempt status. When you donate to our Ministry, it is fully tax deductible when filing your annual Income Tax return, similar to the deduction of your tithes paid to Mt. Zion or any other charity.

Moving right along.....

Before moving to Union Street, UTM fed up to 150 people on a weekly basis and provided clothes from our clothes closet of donated items. Since our move, we have been plagued with stove issues yet still managed to provide several large church events with brunch, etc. using an oven with temperature issues and only 2 burners that are almost rotted through!

We recently purchased a wonderful gas stove with funds lovingly donated to our Ministry. The stove is not yet operable due to problems with work, permit restrictions, etc. We're left with the motor running as our desire to get our hungry population fed exceeds our ability to provide without full use of the new stove.

Our vision.....

We have many big plans to help in the community. Offering food and clothing are just the beginning of the needs we can meet and are excited to move forward.

Ms. Betty Perry remains our largest funder, however we are starting to receive small donations sporadically.

We hope you will join us for breakfast sometime, but please remember that we are self-sustaining, so please leave a donation.

UTM looks forward to what God has in store for us in growth and service to our community.
