There were many difficult days as we said goodbye to friends, trained colleagues on our responsibilities, sold our belongings, and packed up our lives into a handful of suitcases (not to mention, Paul was studying for his PhD, and we have a newborn!). It was by far the most stressful time in our married lives, but God is good, and we can now start the next phase of our ministry with a clean slate. ### CONCERNING WOL HUNGARY


**Who is the new Director of the Hungary Bible Institute?** We are so thankful for the ministry of Filipe Santos. Filipe and his wife, Carol, have been a wonderful asset to our ministry team at the Bible Institute in Hungary. Filipe has served as the Dean of Students, Academic Dean, Associate Director of the BI, and now will be stepping into the role of BI Director. We believe that God has uniquely gifted and prepared him for this new task. Please pray for Filipe’s many responsibilities in Hungary. **Did your house sell?** No, unfortunately, our home in Hungary is still on the market. We have dropped the price as much as possible, and are continuing to wait on God’s perfect timing.

**Will you still have a connection with Hungary?** Paul will continue to serve as an adjunct faculty member in Hungary. He will also assist in recruiting guest teachers, promoting the school, and will raise support for student scholarships. We are convinced of the dynamic and strategic ministry of WOL Hungary, and we want to assist this great team as best we can for years to come.

### CONCERNING OUR NEW MINISTRY

**What is Paul’s new role?** Paul is working directly with the Bible Institute in New York to fulfill his new role as International Faculty Coordinator. In this new role, Paul will recruit and vet the Bible Institute’s faculty, with an emphasis on its guest teachers. There are currently seven accredited teaching sites under the Word of Life Bible Institute umbrella. These locations include, New York, Canada (two locations: Ontario and Quebec), Florida, South Korea, Uganda, and most recently, Hungary; more teaching sites will be added in the future. WOL’s vision is to have “One global Bible Institute with strategically positioned teaching sites cooperating together to fulfill a common philosophy, mission, and set of objectives in culturally effective ways.” Paul will assist the Academic Dean in the accreditation processes, with a focus on the international sites. In addition, he will be traveling as an adjunct professor on a yearly basis to the six accredited campuses outside of New York, and he will have opportunities to teach at the non-accredited ones as well. During these trips, Paul will make himself available for staff training and advice as needed. Already his calendar is filling up with trips to Canada, Hungary, Brazil, Ukraine, and Korea just this year! Finally, Paul will be involved in the curriculum evaluation for the Bible Institute sites, and he will continue to write and lead collaborative writing projects. (Q&A continued on back)


**Where are you living?** We are currently living on the Bible Institute campus in Schroon Lake, NY.
