As I noted at the General Mess Meeting in April, there are going to be challenges and opportunities this year. Our primary challenge will be food services for Mess events. All messes have been advised that we may not employ NPP employees within our public galleys (effective April 1, 2017), Until an internal catering cell is stood up, all functions (other than official military functions) will be required to hire caterers for food services. This meant that some of our long-standing events, such as Sunday Supper, became prohibitively expensive given the number of attendees. On another subject, we received feedback requesting events that consider members with young families. We revisited the entertainment schedule and modified some events, and are looking for opportunities to include families in more events. The "What The Truck?" was a good example of a family inclusive event – we have already received very positive feedback. Looking forward as a Committee, we are working to providing the best service possible to make the Wardroom/Gunroom the best Mess in the CAF.
