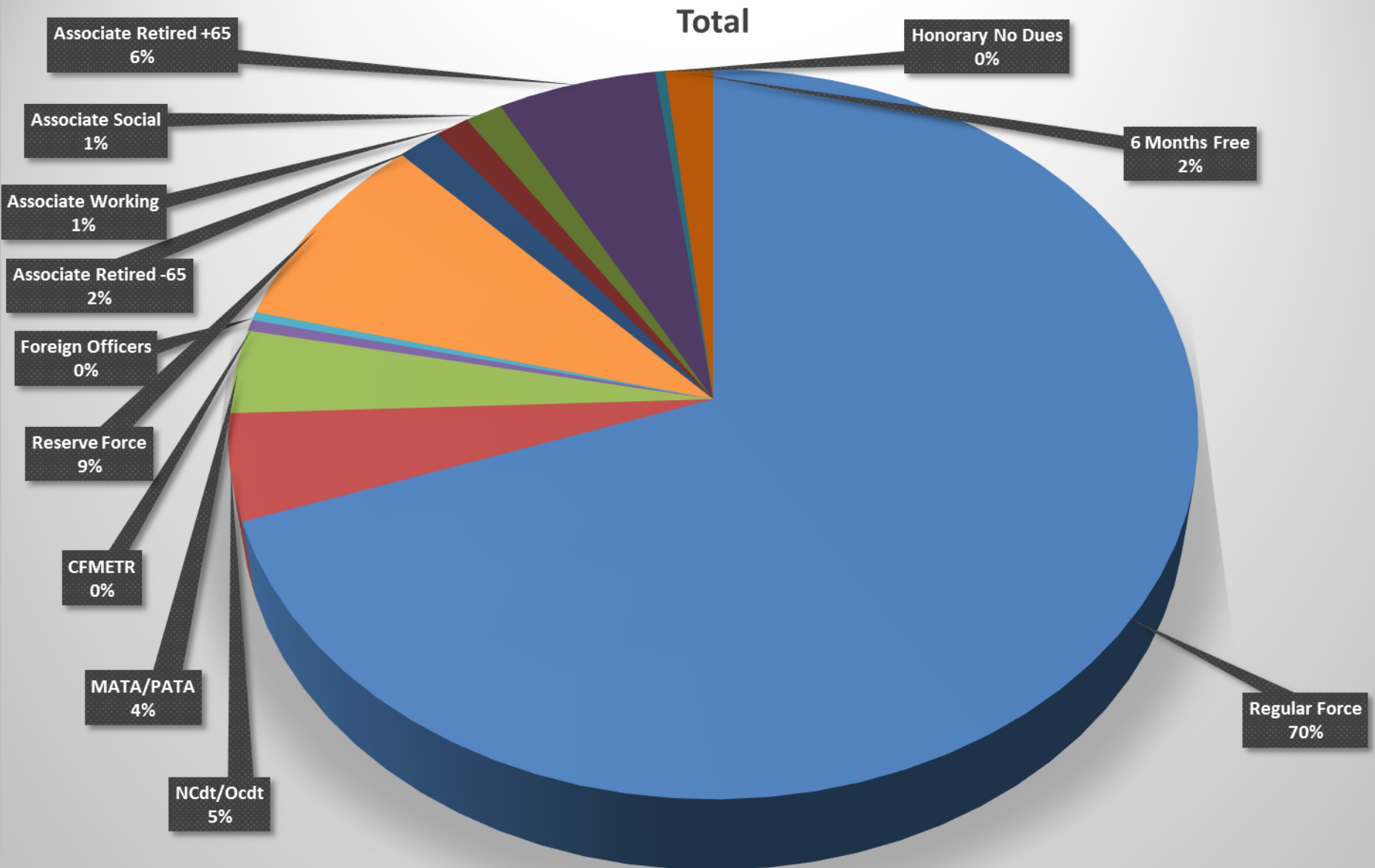

A. Financial Resolution
