The first quarter saw Bombprint shooters Lizzy and Vanessa working well together in the D allowing Bombprint to move into a lead of 9-2.


Team DB defence Ann and Jacqui didn't give up with amazing tight double marking GS with WD and Centre doubling GA keeping her out of the D.
