The meeting opened shortly after 6 p.m. with devotion by President Ed McDowell followed by the acknowledgement of visitors and approval of minutes and agenda with the following changes: parking concerns stricken and Mrs. Myrick, First Calvary Church added.

The freshmen students have arrived at Allen University and the upper-class will return on August 8 and 9. Garden tools were stolen from the Faculty Institute House. Neighbors are asked to call officer Brewer with concerns related to Allen University.

CPD officer Orlando Santos had not received any complaints except for parking. There was an incident on Friday, July 31 that began in Five Points that ended near Waverly with the apprehension of the suspect. Neighbors also were reminded that the police will ticket, tag and tow vehicles not properly licensed that are parked on the road.

The city's Solid Waste Recycling Coordinator, Samantha Yager, talked about the 95 gallon recycling roll carts that will be delivered to each home. Neighbors will receive an information packet with the new cart that contains a letter, kitchen magnet and service card, which will be the second and fourth Friday of the month. You can keep the blue bin or recycle it by placing it inside the new cart.

The balance in the bank is \$1,360.53. Sylvie Dessau reported that \$20 was spent to purchase a gift for the outgoing President/Treasure, William Rutherford, who moved to Washington, D.C.

This year First Calvary is celebrating 150 years. Trustee Cheryl Myrick said to mark the occasion they want an honorary designation along a two block stretch of Pine Street. The church wants to work with the community on the design of the "First Calvary Way" sign.

A motion was made by Ray Borders Gray and seconded by Dr. Gael Rabb for the Action Grant III committee to work with Ms. Myrick. The vote carried. A committee was formed to include: Ms. Myrick, Dr. Rabb, Jeannie McDowell, and Sylvie Dessau.

Another committee will be formed when the weather cools to install the irrigation at the corner of Millwood and Hampton. Upon a motion from Mr. Baker and seconded by Mrs. Rabb, the vote carried to setup two committees.
