## Community Officer's Report

CPD Orlando Santos : there were 3 auto break ins in the past month:

1300 block of Oak St; unsecured vehicle

1400 block of Pine St and 1400 block of Heidt St; in both cases a window was broken and a wallet stolen; there is a possible suspect; update to be provided by Officer Santos to President Houston before April 10

Results of speed monitoring on Pine and Oak Streets: only one citation was issued for speeding (43mph); most vehicles' speed was lower than 30 mph

Frank Houston asked for more frequent patrols because of the break ins; Officer Santos will relay the request but asks Frank Houston to call Dispatch; Frank Houston will send an official request to CPD
