Requirements

Open to composers of all nationalities. A work for solo guitar or two guitars or three guitars (no more than 15 minutes for Emerging Composers and up to 8 minutes for Young Composers). Submitted works must be composed for the six-stringed classical guitar. Alternate tunings are acceptable. Fixed media and/or live electronics may be included. No published or previously awarded compositions should be submitted. Multiple works may be submitted with an application fee of \$10 for each work, which should be submitted online at wpac.fiu.edu (payment link is also provided at migf.org/competition). After completing payment, you will be provided an "order number". Please enter this "order number" above.

Submission Guidelines

The following materials should be submitted via email with attachments to mozgen@fiu.edu by December 15, 2015. The subject line of the email should read "MIGF Composition Competition 2016" followed by your full name.

- Score (and parts, if any) professionally typeset (e.g. Finale, Sibelius) or legibly handwritten and put on a PDF. All pages of the PDF should be anonymous (without the real name of the composer). The first page of score (and parts, if any) should be labeled with the **Pseudonym** (nickname) given on this form, title of the work, and date of composition only.
- Proof of age: copy of passport or driver's license or birth certificate.
- If available, a recording of the submitted work in mp3 audio file format is recommended (MIDI is acceptable).
- This completed and signed application form (scanned PDF with signature).

Adjudication

Judges have the right to award all or some of the prizes or none. Winning compositions will be announced during the Miami International GuitART Festival 2016 and posted online at migf.org.
