DLS IN CONCERT (Detroit Lutheran Singers)

The 2018-2019 concert season of the Detroit Lutheran Singers begins on Saturday, October 20 and Sunday, October 21, with two concerts in the Detroit metro area.

The fall series contains the usual high quality sacred music in diverse styles. The theme for this program chosen by Director Hall is "Made in Michigan" because most of this concert was composed by Michigan composers, or were commissioned for Michigan choirs.

Christopher Hall is in his seventh season as director following more than twenty-five years as a singer in DLS, which he joined after his wife, Doris, became the DLS accompanist. With an impressive background as Director of Music at First United Methodist Church of Birmingham for more than twenty years before retiring from that position, he has brought new energy to DLS, which has been reflected in recent performances.
