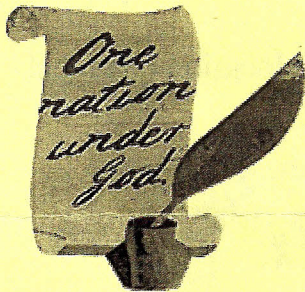
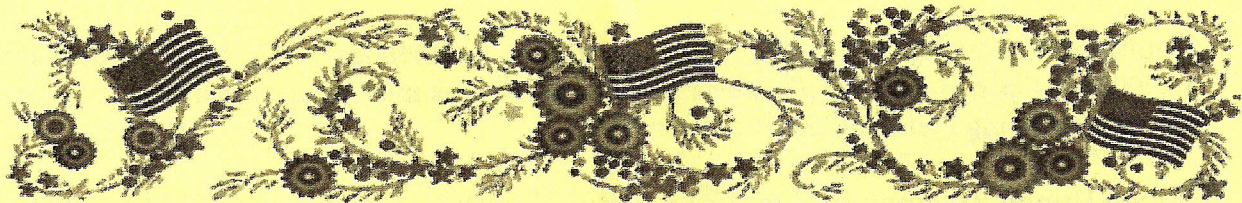

- ◆ Wednesday Mornings 10:00 am in the Lounge (Good Shepherd) Beginning the Book of Romans


