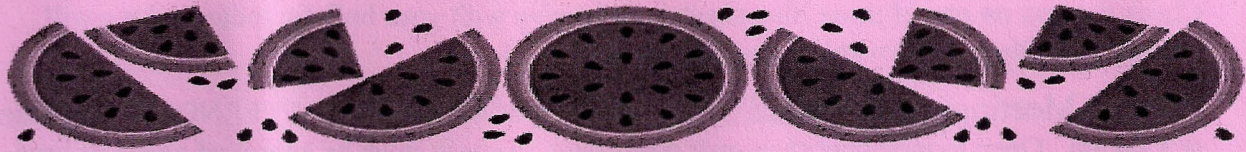
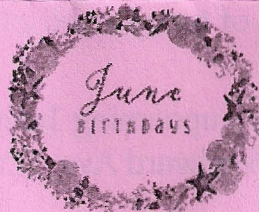


*Living always in the joy of the Resurrection, let us join hearts and voices to praise the Living Lord!*
