Time of Reconciliation (from 1 John)

All: So we confess our sins to God, knowing that God is faithful and just, to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Leader: We now confess our sin to God in silence.

Moment of Silence

Leader: God has sent Jesus to proclaim mercy and forgiveness from sin. God reaches out to those who have no voice – releasing those trapped by shame, and welcoming those scorned by society.

All: In Jesus Christ, we are reconciled to God!


