Reader: Today is the second Sunday of Advent, so we light the second candle on our Advent wreath: the candle of Love.

Reader: Thousands of years ago, Isaiah said that God tends his flock like a shepherd, gathers the lambs in his arms, carries them close to his heart, and gently leads those that have young. Isaiah proclaimed God’s Love for the people.

Reader: Jesus reminded us of that love when he said to his disciples, “As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love... My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you.”

Reader: As we light the candle of Love, we remember the people that we love who are still with us, and also those people we love who have died, and await us in the presence of God.

Reader: Let us pray: God, we proclaim our love for you, and we remember our love for people who are with us, and for people who have passed on. We recognize that love is a blessing, and it comes at a cost.

**All: Fill us with your love, and give us the courage to spread love throughout your world.**

Reader: Help us to remain in your Love, so we may be your light shining in the dark places of our world.
