At school we will continue to get outside as much as we can. We will rake leaves, pile leaves, jump in leaves and make pictures with leaves. Please remember to send children with coats, we will let them take them off if they are too warm.

The dramatic playroom changes into a fire department this month. Canby Fire will visit 3's classes (Andy's Nov 16, Emily's Nov 20), while the 4's and PM classes will visit the fire station on November 17. One note from the firefighters they want us to focus on "get low and go," rather than "stop drop and roll." The theory is that they want children to practice getting out. This would be a good time to talk about an escape plan at your house and then a meeting place once outside. It is also a good time to check smoke detectors and make sure they are working properly. We will continue to have fire drills at school, which is difficult for some children but it is important to practice getting out. Be ready for some questions and reassure them that it is just practice.

November is also a time to reflect on what we are thankful for and as teachers we are so very thankful for such a wonderful group of parents. Your involvement and cooperation is really what makes our school the great place it is. Thank you! Thankfulness is a difficult concept for 3,4 and 5 year olds. Children have a hard time thinking outside of themselves. We will talk about this quite a bit as we prepare for our friendship feast at the end of the month.

We would like to thank those of you who were able to join us at the pumpkin/farm field trip and the carving night. The children love to get together with friends outside of school. Thank you for all the extra help and for the cupcakes, bars, breads, cookies and other treats at the carving night. Wow! We are off to a great start! We have noticed people working on their auction job, turning in donations, selling raffle tickets, and asking great questions!


