Requirements:

- A Written Essay: Why is it important to learn and participate in Swiss heritage? Why are you the best candidate for the Swiss Miss or Ambassador Program? How will being selected as the Swiss Miss or Ambassador be valuable or meaningful to you?
- Parents need to be Current Club Members
- Interview Process

If you are selected you will be required to participate in a few Swiss Events and some community events, such as: The Lodi Grape Festival Parade, Schwingfest, Kids Swiss Camp, and Almond Blossom Parade in Ripon. You might be asked to participate in other events as well.
