#### **UMT Awards Finals Day:**

Some important updates: Teachers must be financial members of the UMT to be able to enter students into these sections.

<u>Auditions</u>: North Western Region: Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> May; North Shore: Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June. Entrants outside of these regions may attend either audition.

**Age limits** apply for each section, and are to be taken as at June 30<sup>th</sup> of the year of the Event.

The UMT Awards (14 years and under) are now to be known as The UMT Junior Award

Anyone who has won <u>any</u> award in this section cannot enter for the next two years, after which they may enter again if they are still age-eligible. They are also free to enter the Roger Woodward Award up to the age of 18 years. Vocalists must be 21 years and under for this section.

The Roger Woodward Award: Open to those up to 18 years of age.

Anyone who has previously won the Roger Woodward Award is ineligible to enter again. Memory work is expected from Pianists and Vocalists, however, it is optional for Instrumentalists. No Age restriction for Vocalists.

<u>The President's Award</u>: This award is open <u>instrumentalists only</u>, who are 19 years and over. This award is currently still under review and may be subject to change.
