## UMT Awards Day – some big changes!

I really urge you to check the rules and regulation for the three awards for this year.

<u>The biggest change</u> is that this year we are trialling the inclusion of duet and small ensemble performances in each section, providing an opportunity for those taking part in the Collaborative Syllabus of the AMEB, or HSC preparation. Only the MAIN performer will be the subject of the adjudication.

We have also tightened up the rules for each section and made the following changes:

All sections: \*Age requirement is as of 30<sup>th</sup> June in the year of entry. \*Teachers must be financial members of the UMT.

**UMT Junior Award** (formally known as UMT Award 14 years and under) – previous winners are not able to re-enter this section for the next two years.

## Roger Woodward Award: no changes

**President's Award**: Prize pool has been increased to \$400 total, it remains for instrumentalists only, and previous winners of this award cannot enter the next year's competition.
