Bringing Out Your Best: Auditions, Leadership, and Musicianship [Reinhardt/Zeitler] **Session 2 (11:00 – 2:00 PM)**

Auditioning and being a leader in your orchestra can be scary and challenging for musicians. We dedicate this session to: 1) Teaching students how to impress judges in the few minutes they have and 2) demonstrating proper practice techniques to make them effective leaders in their orchestra. Students from this session have used what they learned here to successfully audition for GT and All-State Orchestras. Because we focus on coaching on the individual level, we suggest that returning students take this session again!

Building on the Basics [Zeitler] **Session 3 (2:00 – 4:00 PM)**

It is a huge benefit for students in the early stages of playing an instrument to receive individual attention and extra tutoring in note and rhythm reading as well as string playing technique. We will focus on skills introduced in the first few years of orchestra. Wow your teacher with how much you've improved over the summer! This course is recommended for string students entering 4th grade or older students who need some assistance in these areas.

Chamber Music [Reinhardt/Zeitler] **Session 3 (2:00 – 4:00 PM)**

Playing chamber music in a small group ensemble is one of the most fun and rewarding musical experiences you will have! Student-directed groups combine the best parts of solo playing and orchestral playing, developing leadership and musicality. This is geared towards string students entering grades 5-12.

Improv [Beall] **Session 3 (2:00 – 4:00 PM)**

If you enjoy comedy and exploring your creative side, consider joining us for this exciting camp opportunity. Improvisation is a great way to enhance listening and performing skills in an open, collaborative environment. We will play various games and discuss real-life applications for improvisational practice.

Music Theory [AuCoin] **Session 3 (2:00 – 4:00 PM)**

Course designed to strengthen your sight-singing skills by working on melodic and rhythmic notation, key signatures, scales, triads, seventh chords, rhythmic and melodic dictation. Geared towards highly motivated students.

Musical Theatre [AuCoin/Beall] **Session 2 (11:00 – 1:00 PM)**

Come join us this summer for a musical theatre extravaganza! With highlights from Broadway musicals both past and present, this class will culminate in a showcase for family and friends. Participants will have a true Broadway experience as they learn a variety of songs and monologues all while focusing on character development! This is not to be missed!

String Orchestra - Advanced [Reinhardt] **Session 1 (8:00 – 11:00 AM)**

Come experience intensive and fun-filled music making for violin, viola, cello and bass. This is geared toward students entering grades 7-12 or younger students who are playing at a higher level.

String Orchestra - Intermediate [Zeitler] **Session 1 (8:00 – 11:00 AM)**

Join us for a fun and challenging string orchestra setting for violin, viola, cello and bass. This is geared toward students entering grades 4-8 or younger students who are playing at a higher level.

Summer Band [Reichl] **Session 1 (8:00 – 11:00 AM)**

"Band" together for a week of wonderful music making for woodwind, brass, and percussion. Geared toward students entering grades 7-12. Seating is by ability, with the possible separation of an intermediate and advanced ensemble.

Summer Jazz Band [Spang] **Session 2 (11:00 – 2:00 PM)**

A fun and intensive jazz band experience including swing, funk, jazz-rock fusion, and dixieland. Geared toward saxophone, trumpet, trombone as well as guitar, bass, piano, vibes, and drum students entering grades 7-12. Seating is by ability, with the possible separation of an intermediate and advanced ensemble.

Vocal Boot Camp [AuCoin] **Session 1 (8:00 – 11:00 AM)**

Whether you are a soloist or a chorister, get your voice into shape with this intensive course. For all styles and genres, learn some great tricks to keep your voice healthy and focused.
