Session I 8:00AM – 11:00AM

Orchestra – Students will have the opportunity to play a variety of music in an intensive, but fun-filled, large ensemble experience. **Intermediate Orchestra** (Grades 4-8) and **Advanced Orchestra** (Grades 7-12) are offered. Students will showcase what they have learned in a brief concert on the last day.

Session II 11:00AM – 2:00PM

Bringing Out Your Best – Auditioning and being a leader in your orchestra can be scary and challenging for musicians. We dedicate this session to individual help with: solo repertoire, practice habits, audition preparation, overcoming stage fright, and overall technique.

Session III 2:00PM – 4:00PM

Chamber Music – Playing music in small groups (quartets, trios, etc.) is both fun and rewarding. Students will learn about teamwork and musicality in this session geared toward string students entering grades 5-12.

OR

Building on the Basics – This session is perfect for younger students who would benefit from individual help with note-reading, rhythm, and string technique. We focus on skills introduced in the first year of playing.
