13 year old Carson Domey was diagnosed with orofacial granulomatosis, a rare chronic inflammatory disorder when he was just seven years old. He was then diagnosed with Crohn's disease in 2014. And although faced with these challenges, he doesn't seem to have slowed down much.

Carson has raised thousands of dollars for Boston Children's Hospital. And he is also using his voice to help the hospital's Office of Government Relations promote a bill in the state legislature. This bill would expand insurance coverage for telemedicine. Telemedicine allows a doctor to remotely consult with a patient through audio and video technology. This is important when a patient, like Carson, doesn't feel well enough to get in a vehicle and travel to an appointment. It's Carson's hope that this will soon be covered by insurance.

Carson has also found his passion in politics. In 2044, he wants to be on the presidential ballot. He finds it interesting that someone like him can serve others and represent them, and that we as Americans have that freedom to do so. He especially has an interest in foreign affairs, and how each government relates to others.

He has interned for state Senator Ryan Fattman. Before Carson runs for President, he would like to work at the state department or Congress.
