

# Hoyer Homestead Farm & CSA, LLC Member Agreement 2018

### The CSA Concept

CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture. CSA is a means of providing fresh, high quality produce to "members" who purchase a "share" of the harvest from a local farmer. Prior to the onset of the growing season, CSA members pay up front to help cover the cost of growing produce. Once harvesting begins, members receive their weekly "share" of the harvest. Members benefit from receiving locally grown produce, picked fresh when it is most flavorful and highest in nutrients, with no seasonal market price fluctuations. The farmer benefits by planting produce according to a known number of CSA members.

## **Hoyer Homestead's Agreement**

Hoyer Homestead will provide fresh, local produce to you, the "member" according to the "share" package you sign up for. We grow quality produce using organic, sustainable practices. Greenhouse hydroponic and raised-bed methods help us to lengthen the growing season. We raise cage-free, omega-3 enhanced brown chicken eggs and co-op with a local orchard and farmer to provide a larger variety of produce.

#### Sharing the Risks and Rewards

We will do our best to provide you with a bountiful variety of quality produce each week. The quantity may vary week-to-week based on weather conditions, pests, or other factors. Typically we are able to compensate for failed crops by providing other produce that can be harvested at the same time. However, the possibility exists that a tornado or other extreme event could destroy an entire crop. By joining our CSA, you are agreeing to share in the risk of crop failure with us and the other CSA members.

Members are also able to share in the rewards of a *bumper crop*. During the height of the growing season you will likely take extra items home that your family prefers in addition to that week's "share". That is our way of *thanking you* for your loyal membership. In addition, you will be offered the opportunity to purchase extras of items such as sweet corn, apples, and basil for parties, freezing and canning, and seasonal add-on items.

# **Produce Expected in 2018**

Varieties offered vary based on past performance and some annual experimentation. Heirloom and cross-pollinated hybrids are planted. Produce timing is based on typical weather conditions.

- Early Summer (June-mid-July): arugula, beans, beets, bok choy, broccoli, carrots, cucumbers, garlic scapes, green onions, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce (e.g. Salanova butter crunch, spring mix, leaf, romaine), peas, radishes, spinach, summer squash, Swiss chard, turnips, seasonal herbs (e.g. cilantro)
- Summer (mid-July August): beans, beets, broccoli, carrots, cucumbers, garlic, summer squash, kale, kohlrabi, leeks, musk melon, onions, peppers (sweet and hot), sweet corn, Swiss chard, tomatoes and cherry tomatoes (variety), watermelon, seasonal herbs (e.g. basil, dill),
- Late Summer (September October): apples, arugula, beans, beets, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cucumbers, garlic, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce (e.g. Salanova butter crunch, spring mix, leaf, romaine), melon, peas, radishes, spinach, summer squash, sweet corn, Swiss chard, tomatillos, tomatoes and cherry tomatoes (variety), turnips, winter squash, seasonal herbs (e.g. parsley, thyme)

#### **CSA Member Agrees To:**

- 1. Bring the CSA box I receive from Hoyer Homestead with me each week.
- 2. Pick up my share of produce during the timeframe listed for my chosen delivery site.
- 3. Check in with Hoyer staff to learn about that week's produce options prior to filling my box.
- 4. Notify Hoyer at least a day in advance if someone else will be picking up my share by email: hoyerhomestead@gmail.com, or call or text: 262-492-2989\*.

If no one picks up my share it will be donated to a pantry or shelter.

\* We are typically in the garden during the day, not the office, so will generally communicate by email.
