



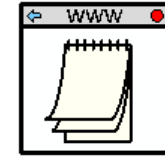

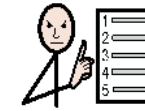
Safety

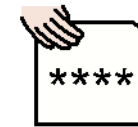

When making a username for a site or game we must not use our real name.

We must not give out personal information.



We should speak to an adult we know and trust if we feel uncomfortable with any contact or incident that may happen.

 When choosing a password or username do not include your name, age, date of birth or address. 

 Choose a password that only you will know. For example, your favourite song, or character from a TV show/film. 

 Include lower case and UPPER CASE letters in your password.. 

 Include numbers and symbols in your password. For example cherry12+= + %

 Don't tell people your password. Only tell your parents/family members and adults you know and trust. 

 Always tell an adult if you feel unsure of something that happens when online.
