Our club Junior Development Officer, *Richard Williams*, is responsible for

ensuring that our child protection policy is implemented, and can be contacted on *07922 182 183* should you have any concerns.

Arrangements should be made for your child to travel to and from training sessions and matches. We appreciate it if children can arrive promptly and are collected promptly at the end of the session, if they are not making their own way home. If you are going to be late picking your child up, please contact our junior coach,

*Richard Williams* on *07922 182 183* and let him know.

We welcome parents to all training and competitions and value your support.

### Why not look into full junior membership...

Did you know, if your child trains in 2 or more sessions per week and plays 2 games per month you will be spending around £36 per month. Bear in mind your child could potentially be training 3 times per week and play 4 games in a month costing you at least £64!!!

Full junior membership is only £20 per month, is set up as a standing order over 12 months and is far easier to maintain. Once it's set up you don't need to do any more for the year and no more handing loads of cash to your child every week!!!

- To become junior member you must be under 18 years old and in full time education
- As a full member of Nuneaton Volleyball Club you understand that the membership commitment is for one whole year. The reason we can offer so much volleyball during the season for relatively little cost is that the cost is spread out over the whole 12 months.
