# Acceptable Material

## PAPER RECYCLING

### Cardboard

- Flattened corrugated cardboard
- **NO WAXED Cardboard**

### Newspaper

- Newsprint
- Any items that come in the newspaper can be recycled with the newspaper.

### Mixed Paper

- Thin box board- cereal, Kleenex, paper rolls, and soap boxes etc.
- Photocopy paper, colored or white
- Envelopes including window style
- Shredded paper ( Please keep in tied bags)
- All glossy flyers, magazines, catalogs & telephone books

### Sorted Office Paper

- Computer, copier paper, white bond & ledger paper envelopes without windows, and shredded paper.

## PLASTIC RECYCLING

### Plastic Film

- Clean plastic bags
- Store in tied garbage bags

### Mixed Numbered Plastic

- Cap' less, clean and crushed
- Food containers, condiment containers, laundry, dish soap container, etc.
- **NO Styrofoam or #7 Water Jugs Please!**

## AGRICULTURAL RECYCLING

(Refer to Agricultural Recycling Brochure for more Information)

### Silage Wrap and Twine

- Must be clean: no dirt, seeds, etc.
- Twine and netting to be separated and stored in bags.

### Agricultural Pesticide Containers

- MUST be triple rinsed, punctured, and empty.
- Booklets removed and recycled.

## METAL RECYCLING

### Tin Cans

- Rinsed with labels removed.

### Scrap Metal

- Appliances
- Other Metal
- **NO Automobiles or Vehicle Parts**

## OTHER RECYCLING

### Household Hazardous Waste & Paint

- Aerosols (paint or household), cleaners, chemicals, insecticides, waxes, fluorescent bulbs etc.
- Latex, or Oil base household paint.

### E-Waste

- Computer monitors, CPU's, printers, TV's  
(Subject to Change)

### Yard Waste Materials

- Grass clippings, light yard waste and brush.

### Ni-Cd Rechargeable Batteries

- Cell phones, cordless phones, power tool, laptop, etc.

### Alkaline Batteries

- AA, AAA, 9V, 6V, etc.

### Used Tires

- Passenger, semi and off-road tires

### FREON CONTAINING APPLIANCES

- \$20.00 Fee per appliance
- Freon Containing Appliances only accepted at the Rocky Transfer Station
