- x Bulk Liquid Waste

Surcharges & fines:

- **Prohibited Waste:** If a person or company knowingly disposes of prohibited materials will face a fine and clean up costs.
- **Illegal & AFTERHOURS Dumping:** Any Person caught dumping waste, outside the transfer site or waste facility area will be reported and charged accordingly.
- **Un-Secured/ Un-Covered Loads:** Any person caught with an un-secure or un-covered load may be reported and fined.

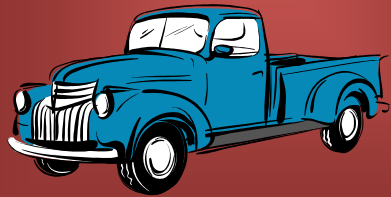


Residential & Commercial Waste Disposal Guide

Solid Waste Transfer Stations only accept the waste delivered in a pickup truck or vehicle of similar size. ALL LARGE VEHICLES WILL BE SENT TO THE ROCKY REGIONAL LANDFILL.



Acceptable Material:

Residential & Commercial Waste Description:

- ✓ Un-recyclable materials
- ✓ Household Waste
- ✓ Painted, stained, or preserved wood materials
- ✓ Ceramics, mirrors, wired glass and windshields
- ✓ Waxed cardboard
- ✓ Drywall and mixed demolition

Wood Materials:

- ✓ Description: Dry Timber, or wood that has not been chemically treated or painted.

Brush/ Yard Waste Materials:

- ✓ I.e.: Brush, tree limbs, grass, etc.



Other Household Items & Electronics:

- ✓ i.e.: chairs, tables, couches, desks, microwaves, stereos, mattresses, box springs, and other similar items

Sorted Dry Inert Waste (Landfill Only):

- ✓ i.e.: concrete, rocks, asphalt shingles

Burn Barrel Ash and Residue

- ✓ Ashes will only be accepted at the Regional Landfill in a specific location

PLEASE NOTE: that the Rocky Mountain Regional Solid Waste Authority promotes recycling and bagged garbage rather than burning!
