

BE PREPARED TO HAVE YOUR REFUND DIRECTLY DEPOSITED

The fastest way to get your refund is by using direct deposit. In order to do that, you will need to bring your routing and account numbers for your bank account or check card.

You can find these numbers on the bottom of your check. If you do not have a check, ask your bank to give you the information.

NOTE: *Deposit slips don't always have the correct information for direct deposit, so bring a check or a direct deposit form from your bank.*

VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE (VITA) PROGRAM

Through the **VITA** program, volunteers are certified by the IRS to prepare your tax returns for free. When you come to a **VITA** site, make sure you have everything you need to complete your tax returns.

YOU MUST BRING:

YOUR TAXES WILL NOT BE COMPLETED WITHOUT THESE



- Photo Identification
- Social Security cards or statements for **EVERYONE** on the tax return
- Birth dates for **EVERYONE** on the tax return
- All Earning statements: Such as W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, 1099-Misc, 1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-B

NOTE:

- The **VITA** program is for households making less than \$66,000 per year, so add up your earnings before you come.
- During intake, a volunteer will review your documents to ensure that your return is eligible for preparation through the **VITA** program.

YOU MAY NEED TO BRING:

Are you a student or repaying a student loan?

- Statements from your university or college, **1098-T**
- Student loan interest statement, **1098-E**

Do you have a child in childcare?

- Total paid and provider's tax ID number

Did you buy insurance from healthcare.gov?

- Affordable Health Care Statements, **1095-A**

Are you self-employed?

- Totaled mileage records
- Totaled business income and expenses

Eligible for the WV Homestead Exemption?

- Form **WV-SCTC** from the WV State Tax office

IF AVAILABLE, BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- Last year's federal and state returns
- Routing and accounts numbers for direct deposit
