### Saving America



I am so glad that we have the opportunity to go hear Dr. Fady Al-Hagal on the relevant issue of Muslims in our culture. Dr. Al-Hagal was born and grew up in Damascus Syria, a nation ruled and dominated by Islam.

Syria is a nation torn by extreme Islamic Jihadist movements resulting in the death of over two hundred thousand people since 2010.

Dr. Fady, as he is commonly called, grew up in a Christian home despite the fact that only ten percent of Syria is Christian. Even though he was in a Christian home, he did not become a Christian until he was living in America as a student at UT-Martin in 1984. Later he surrendered to the Gospel ministry and is now a pastor in the Martin area. In 1991 he became an American citizen. Go with us to First Baptist, Trenton on February 8th to hear Dr. Fady preach on "Saving America from the Extreme Influence of Islam."

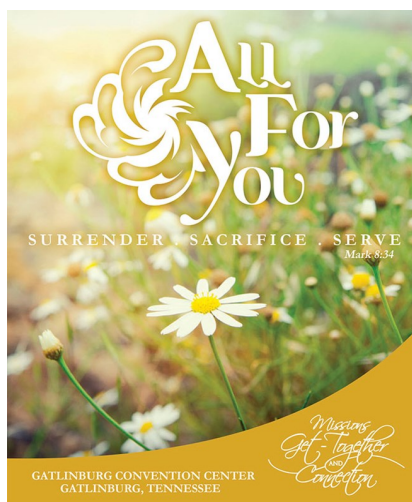
##### Featured Speaker
