FROM THE PASTOR

As I write this article for the new year, I absolutely cannot believe that 2017 has come and gone. Is it possible for time to travel any faster than it already does? This past year was a great year, most notably within the ministries of White Hall. Our Vacation Bible School was the best ever. I just don't know how we get better each year, but I hope we continue that trend.

The Fall Festival was tremendous, despite the weather that refused to cooperate. The food, festivities, music and of course the candy were great. Each year the Fall Festival is one of the best ways for us to reach our community for Christ.

A new ministry event this year that ranks right up there with these other two was the Operation Inasmuch day. Seventy church members, at fifteen locations, preforming five different ministries. We conservatively estimate that we touched the lives of 450 individuals that day. This one day of missions was an incredible way of the church demonstrating the love of Christ to the world around us. And I look forward to many more ways for us to share the good news of Jesus Christ with a lost and dying world in 2018.



As the new year begins, one way that you can help the church is by helping us purchase a new van. The church vans are incredible tools to help us reach people for Christ and allow us to minister to those in need.

A few months ago the church formed a committee to replace our oldest 15 passenger van and with a newer van. The old van has become more troublesome as it has aged and continued to put on miles. This committee has already begun researching vans for sale and is looking at both new and used vans and will pursue the best option considering whatever we can afford.

This is where you can help. I would like to ask our church to begin praying for our van ministry. It is an incredibly valuable resource for the church, but it is also incredibly difficult to oversee. So pray for the coordinator and all the drivers and riders.

Also, as you are praying, ask God if He would use you to be a part of the van ministry. One of the challenges of the van ministry is "burn-out." We do not want to over tax any of our divers, riders, or the coordinator to the point of burn out. If we only had enough volunteers who would rotate, then this would not occur. Ask God if He would like to use you once a month to help with this valuable ministry.

Finally, I would like for you to pray to God about how much you should support financially toward the purchase of a van. Since the old van is worn down and needs to be replaced, we need your assistance to help us with this purchase. As you pray, let the Lord impress upon your heart how much you should give to help this ministry reach more people for Christ. Our first goal to reach is \$25,000. Once we achieve that goal, then the new van committee can determine what to do next. As you can see from the gas gauge in this article, we still have a long way to go. We need you.
