On April 21, 1942, a large crowd gathered in a home in the community with the shared purpose of organizing a Baptist church in the White Hall community. The congregation decided in August of 1942 to build a permanent home for their worship services. White Hall Baptist Church broke ground on March 22, 1943. The original building was paid for as it was built. On July 11, 1943, just 15 months after the church was organized, the first services were held in the new building. God has blessed the history of White Hall Baptist Church.

On April 30, 2017, we are expecting another large crowd to gather to celebrate what God has done over the past 75 years. Former pastors have committed to return, including Brother Mike Kemper, who will be the guest preacher for the
