WEATHER POLICIES

SUPBALL will always endeavour to go ahead with games and training. We know SUPBALL Players are a hardy bunch and we will always endeavour to get you out on the water come rain or shine. Please be aware, however, that we are restricted by certain wind and other weather conditions that would make it dangerous to be out on the waters of Manly Wharf.

The area in which we operate is located between Dobroyd Head and North Head. This area is known as Manly Cove. The entrance to the Cove faces directly south making the area susceptible to weather fronts from southerly and westerly directions. With this in mind we monitor the following conditions:

WINDS

Any winds from S, SSW, SW, WSW and W directions will be closely monitored. Winds over 20 knots from these directions will be unsafe to operate and we will cancel games and training. Winds over 10 knots will be closely monitored and conditions will be assessed on the day.

RAIN

Light rain and overcast conditions will not impact our operation and we will go ahead with games and training in these conditions.

STORM ACTIVITY

We will not operate in storm activity of any kind.

CANCELLATION CALLS

We will always give as much notice as possible for game and training cancellations. All calls are final. The latest time the calls will be made are:

- Saturday AM Training - 7:00am
- Saturday AM Competition Games - 7:00am
- Sunday PM Training - 1:00pm
