CODE OF CONDUCT

SUPBALL's Code of Conduct is maintained and updated annually by Aquatic Adventure Group Pty Ltd.



1. CODE OF CONDUCT - PLAYERS

- 1.1** Honour both the spirit and letter of the SUPBALL Rules and live up to the highest ideals of ethics and sportsmanship; avoid gamesmanship, and respect the traditions of the game.
- 1.2** Your safety and the safety of your team mates and opponents comes first. Be aware of, and always comply with, the SUPBALL Rules as well as Safety Policies and Guidelines.
- 1.3** Be a good sport, displaying modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat.
- 1.4** Treat everyone equally, fairly and with dignity regardless of gender or gender identity, sexual orientation, ethnicity, cultural or religious background, age or disability. Any form of bullying, harassment, discrimination, racial intolerance, profanity, obscene gestures, offensive remarks, taunting or other actions that are demeaning to other players, officials or supporters have no place in SUPBALL.
- 1.5** Do not repeatedly breach the SUPBALL Rules relating to Foul Play or Misconduct.
- 1.6** Accept and respect the authority of a referee, assistant referee, scorekeeper or other match or team official. Do not abuse, threaten or intimidate, use crude language or gestures, or show unnecessary obvious dissension, displeasure or disapproval towards a referee, assistant referee, scorekeeper or other match or team official, whether on or off the court.
- 1.7** Care for and respect the facilities and equipment made available to you during training and competition.
- 1.8** Use Social Media appropriately. By all means share your positive experiences of SUPBALL but do not use Social Media as a means to discredit SUPBALL, its officials, teams or players. Do not use it to breach any of the expectations and requirements of you as a player contained in SUPBALL.
- 1.9** Do not otherwise act in a way that may adversely affect or reflect on, or bring you, your team, or SUPBALL into disrepute or discredit.
- 1.10** You must assist in any investigation or disciplinary proceedings and ensure that no inaccurate and/or misleading information is provided by you during the course of an investigation or hearing under this Code or in relation to any other disciplinary proceedings.
- 1.11** Show concern and caution towards sick and injured players.
