## North State Road 9 Trailhead

The Blue River Recreational Trails are open year round. The 10' path is completely paved from end to end, with a deck at the east end offering beautiful views of Blue River Memorial Park and the Little Blue River.

From the North 9 Trailhead, historic downtown Shelbyville is only 3 blocks away, and the Porter Visitors Center is across the street. Look for public art and the solar system sculptures dotted along the way.

The Blue River Walking Trail is clearly marked along the complete 4.3 miles of trail. Look for the sign shown to the left, and you'll enjoy the rivers, artwork and nature at its best.



Currently, there are 5 nesting pair of Bald Eagles in Shelby County. Keep on the lookout for these amazing raptors. It is a Federal offense to take, possess, transport, sell, import, or export their nests, eggs and parts that are taken in violation of any state, tribal or U.S. law.
