The parents will be required to sign an incident report, which documents the behavior and action taken.
2.	Upon the second infraction, the child will be removed from the activity and placed in "time-out". He/she will be made aware of the reasoning for the punishment and the consequences. The camp director will directly contact the parents and inform them of the situation. The parents will be required to sign an incident report, which documents the behavior and action taken. The parents will be warned that any further infractions will result in removal from
3.	the camp. Upon the third infraction, the child will be removed from the activity and asked to sit in the director's office. The director or supervisor will notify the parent and request that the child be removed immediately. At this point the child will not be allowed to return to camp.
