



Nick Williamson Lone Buffalo Co-founder/Lead Teacher

After the sudden passing of Teacher Manophet, Mark Steadman brought 'Teacher' Nick Williamson to Phonsavan to help keep Manophet's English Development School open for the rest of that term.

Subsequently Mark and Nick pledged to open a new centre in Manophet's memory. In 2011 the two returned to Laos to set things up, and in February 2012 the Lone Buffalo English Development Centre was established.

Nick's unique teaching style got Lone Buffalo noticed both in Phonsavan and beyond. Nick established the first teacher training sessions, which eventually led to former student Kong Lee becoming Lone Buffalo's first local teacher. His contribution to the establishment of Lone Buffalo was crucial.

Nick currently lives in London, and plans to return to Asia to teach in the future.
