Terms & Conditions relating to the Warranty of new Swimsuit Dryer units.

1) DEFINITIONS

“Company” means *The Swimsuit Dryer Company Limited*.

“Client” means the person, firm or company placing an order with the Company.

“Goods” means any goods and/or services provided by the Company as ordered by the Client.

2) WARRANTY

2.1 The Company warrants that the Goods will be supplied using reasonable care and skill.

2.2 Any Swimsuit Dryers supplied by the Company or appointed distributors will receive a 12 month warranty from supply date. The warranty will cover the Swimsuit Dryer for replacement of any faulty parts that may occur during the 12 month period and labour fees for works, subject to 4) *LIMITATION OF WARRANTY*.

2.3 Warranty excludes any and all shipping and freight costs.

2.4 Any faulty Swimsuit Dryer under warranty **must be returned to the Company’s factory in the original packaging** supplied in the original purchase. Any damage received in transit due to incorrect packaging by the client shall be fully chargeable for all parts and labour time. Replacement packaging is available from the Company, which is chargeable to the Client. Shipping costs of replacement packaging must be paid by the Client.

2.5 Unless specified in writing any unauthorised work carried out on a Swimsuit Dryer by a non- authorised Company employee will immediately void any warranties given by the Company.

2.6 Removal of the Top Ring for cleaning and maintenance purposes as directed in the instruction manual supplied with units will not invalidate the warranty, so long as it is reattached properly and nothing is left inside the drum.

2.7 The Company will dispose of any packaging The Client has supplied with the goods on arrival that is not suitable for purpose.

3) 24 MONTH EXTENDED WARRANTY

3.1 The Company offers a 24 month warranty covering the motor and breaking components. The 24 month extended warranty does not cover labour and is subject to all terms in section

4) *LIMITATION OF WARRANTY.*

4) LIMITATION OF WARRANTY

4.1 The Company shall not be liable to repair units under warranty when large amounts of water have been poured through a unit, when a unit has received damage from vandalism or negligence or when installation instructions in user manual supplied have not been correctly followed.

4.2 The Company shall not be liable to repair units under warranty when damage is caused due to lack of maintenance including but not limited to non-removal of blockages from drum causing water to overflow. Blockages must be removed promptly by unscrewing the top ring with special screwdriver provided and taking out the blockage.

4.3 The Company reserves the right to apply an additional charge for cleaning in the event that a customer has not regularly cleaned a unit during warranty period, as directed in the instruction manual.

4.4 The Company shall not be liable to repair units under warranty when the Client has modified or disassembled a Swimsuit Dryer for any reason, unless agreed in writing by the Company.

4.5 The Company reserve the right to charge an administration fee if unit is in full working order upon arrival if sent in for repair and no repair or servicing is required (eg. If non-operation is caused by the RCD set to off position or motor circuit breaker not pressed).
