3<sup>rd</sup> SPIRIT—of Christmas Yet to Be-large Grim Reaper sort, 15 lines

FRED-Scrooge's nephew, Young man, 20's, 2 scenes, 40 lines

BESS-Fred's Wife-1 scene, 5 lines

1<sup>ST</sup> BUSINESSMAN/Man- 2 scenes, 20 lines

2<sup>ND</sup> BUSINESSMAN/Man-2 scenes, 20 lines

YOUNG BOY SCROOGE/PETER-2 scenes, 15 lines-looks age 9-12

FAN, Scrooge's young sister—1 scene, 12 lines-looks age 9-12

YOUNG MAN SCHROOGE-1 scene, 12 lines-looks 16-20

FEZZIWIG-Young Man Scrooge's Employer-older man-1 scene, 10 lines

MRS. FEZZIWIG-1 scene, 10 lines

DICK WILKINS-employee at Fezziwig's, 5 lines

BELLE-a young lady, 1 scene 12 lines

YOUNG LADY-with Dick Wilkins at Fezziwig's party,

MRS. CRATCHIT-2 scenes, 28 lines

BELINDA, MARTHA, BOY, GIRL, TINY TIM-2 scenes-several lines each-ages 5-12

TOPPER-Fred's friend, 5 lines, possible caroler

CLARA-Bess's sister, 1 scene, 3 lines

MRS DILBER-charwoman, 1 scene, 20 lines

THE UNDERTAKER 1 scene, 8 lines

MAID-1 scene, 6 lines

OLD JOE-1 scene, 15 lines

ERRAND BOY-1 scene, 5 lines-age 9-12
