We are excited to send home this information about next semester and our culminating show, “Charlotte’s Web” which will be performed at Farr Best Theatre. Please read ALL information, and contact Marty Fredrick with any questions. Her contact information is below. SECOND SEMESTER CLASSES

We will have the same wonderful teachers and almost the same times, but new location. **Classes will be held at MCT classroom, 1557 E. Broad Street, Suite 103 - where costumes and offices are also.** Payments will be handled the same as before, and prices are the same:

Monday Classes:

- Begin Monday, January 15th / Last class will be March 26th / Culminating show will be April 3rd
- Classes @ 4:30pm
- Classes are \$60 x 3 installments or \$180 x 1 installment

Tuesday Classes:

- Begin Tuesday, January 9th / Last class will be March 27th / Culminating show will be April 3rd
- **January and February** classes will be:
 - 2nd-4th grade @ 5:00-5:45pm
 - 5th-9th grade @ 6:00-7:00pm
- **March** classes **will be combined:**
 - 2nd-9th grade @ 5:30-7:00pm (note the time change, and longer classes)
 - Classes will combine for rehearsals for “Charlotte’s Web.”
 - Students will be engaged in learning activities at all times.
- 2nd-4th grade Classes are \$80 x 3 installments or \$240 x 1 installment
- 5th-9th grade Classes are \$100 x 3 installments or \$300 x 1 installment

“Charlotte’s Web” is a wonderful full-length play adapted by Joseph Robinette from the book by E. B. White and includes all the same characters and story line. We want to give the students a real theatre experience and are going to rent Farr Best Theatre for the day! We will have sets and costumes and not charge for tickets but will need to charge a **production fee of \$20 per student**. All students will perform, although the Tuesday classes will have the main roles. Monday students will have minor roles and get stage experience, too.

The one performance will be April 3rd and PLANS AT THIS TIME INCLUDE that they will be expected to come to the theatre at 4:00, rehearse, eat and get into costume and make up for the play at 6:30pm. Auditions will be a positive and good learning experience!! **Monday class will work on characters but are not expected to audition.**

NOTE: Students will actually be getting several more hours of instruction time with an additional Sunday, March 4th Run Through plus Dress rehearsal and then the performance, etc.

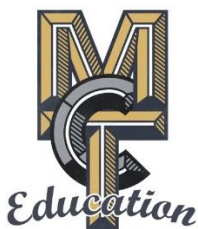
