ACTING AUDITIONS: Read through and know the following characters. Auditions consist of performing lines in character, using projection, body language, movement, etc., for that role. Although the cast is much larger, auditioning for one of the following will allow the directors to determine the roles. Cold readings MAY be part of your audition as determined by directors.

VOCAL AUDITIONS: If you want a lead role, please be prepared to sing no more than 16 bars of *"The Prince Is Having a Ball"* or *"In My Own Little Corner"* or *"Ten Minutes Ago I Saw You"* or *"Impossible"* or something that showcases your voice and the role you are seeking. Bring your own CD or accompaniment. Leads have solos and many chorus members have small solos.

CINDERELLA—happy, young lady, with vivid imagination (vocal and dance training helpful) "Oh, I wish, I wish, that I could be at the ball tonight. Do you know what I was wishing tonight? That the pumpkin in the yard would turn into a great big golden carriage and take me to the ball." PRINCE—Strong, warm, sensitive young man (vocal training helpful)

"It isn't a night I'm looking forward to. Dancing with all those....candidates. Every simpering girl in the Kingdom, each one determined to show she would be the perfect princess."

GODMOTHER—down to earth sensible woman—not the fairy godmother usually thought of "Do you know what I would do? I'd leave them. If you want to be a servant, you can go to some other place and be paid! You have got to help yourself, you know."

STEPMOTHER-not really evil but self-absorbed—haughty

"On our shopping tour today I bought you the most beautiful clothes my purse could afford. (voice hardens) So whether or not you marry the prince, you'll marry somebody this year!"

PORTIA, STEPSISTER-not very bright

(trying to impress the prince at the ball) "I'm gonna be a lawyer! Just like my namesake in Shakespeare's "The Merchant of Venice. Her name was Portia, too! Know what I mean?"

JOY, STEPSISTER-not joyous...never smiles

"Your Highness, may I say something personal? I think...I think...Very nice weather for this time of year."

HERALD-official spokesman for royal family-very dignified

"The Prince is having a ball! His royal highness, Christopher Rupert Windermere Vladimere Karl Alexander is giving a ball!"

KING-more normal husband and father than self-righteous royal

"Why should I worry about him? He seems happy all right. And if he is happy, why should he get married? And a ball--- That will cost so much money!"

QUEEN-older, very motherly, anxious for son to find right girl

"A fine father you are. You never worry about him. I so want him to be happy...and if he is happy, he should get married."

CHORUS ROLES INCLUDE: MAIDS, JESTER, CHEF, COACHMAN, FOOTMAN, CHEESE STEWARD, BUTCHER, WINE STEWARD, BOY, KID SISTER, FEED SALESMAN, MICE, WHITE HORSES, TOWNSPEOPLE, BALL ATTENDEES and include dancing and singing in big stage numbers!
