

Goals include building self-esteem, encouraging imagination, and learning basic theatre skills including stage directions, projection, character development, theatre etiquette. Each class includes review for past students and incorporates new lessons for everyone.

FEES are based on 12 classes per semester and includes any rehearsal time and extra instruction. 30 min classes are \$80/month or \$240/semester & All other classes are \$100/month or \$300/semester.

MCT EDUCATION GUIDELINES

The goal of Mainstage Classic Theatre Education is to provide children with outstanding theatre teaching and training. We choose to do this in a manner that is encouraging and focuses on growth.

Please read, understand, and agree to the following guidelines for MCT Education Classes:

□ Attendance

- o Students will be on time to class, and parents will ensure pick up occurs on time. Students must be signed in and out.
- o Students who are absent will be given any missed materials the next class, but the class will not be refunded or "made up". Parents need to contact the teacher if student will be absent.
- o Classes cancelled due to weather and/or MISD cancellations will not be made up or refunded.
- o Classes cancelled due to other issues (teacher, etc.) will be made up if possible.

□ Payment

- o Payment is **due on the first day of class each month** or can be paid at the beginning of the semester in one installment.
- o A \$5 late fee will be added per week that payment is late.
- o Payment may be made in cash, credit card or check.
- o Once the month, or semester (depending on pay plan), has begun refunds will not be made.

□ Behavior

- o Students will be respectful of self, others and surroundings.
- o Language and conversation will always be rated G.

\Box Dress Code

o Modest clothing that is comfortable for movement is best!

o Dresses, skirts and flip flops make movement and sitting difficult. Tennis shoes are necessary!

□ Teacher/Parent Communication

- o If there is ever an issue, please contact the Education Coordinator first. The coordinator will help in ensuring the situation is resolved.
- o If there is a discipline issue in class, the teacher will give verbal correction only. If the problem persists the teacher will contact the coordinator, and she will take it from there.

□ Security

- o Students will be signed in and out for ALL classes
- o A Driver's License is needed to check a student out
- o Only those listed on the registration form will be allowed to pick a student up
