

LINES TO MEMORIZE FOR ROLES:

TROY: Gabriella, what you heard yesterday, none of that is true. I was sick of my friends riding me about singing with you, and I said things I knew would shut them up. Maybe that's because I don't want to be just "the basketball guy" anymore. I'm going to sing.

GABRIELLA: Must be tricky being the coach's son. At my other school, I was always "the freaky math girl." I hated it. Remember how cool kindergarten was? You'd meet somebody, and ten minutes later you were best friends. Anyway, thanks for showing me your top-secret hiding place.

SHARPAY: They're up to something! Ryan, we need to save our show from people who don't know the difference between a Tony Award and Tony Hawk. I'll tell Darbus that Troy and his dad want to sabotage the auditions because she gave him detention. She'll believe anything I tell her because I'm the president of the Drama Club.

RYAN: Ms. Darbus, Troy wasn't trying to screw up the auditions. Sharpay lied to you because she was afraid of losing the part. That's the truth!

CHAD: Yo, dog! Troy, my man on the hoops! It will be a happy Wildcat New Year, when Troy Bolton leads us to our first league championship in ten years!

ZEKE: Dude, you are so totally awesome! If you can come out in the open about singing, then I can tell my secret too. I love to bake!
