

### At once they left their nets and followed him. Matthew 4:20

from Living Faith Booklet on Thursday November 30 - St. Andrew feast.

Today the Church remembers in a special way the apostle St. Andrew. I wonder if Andrew often felt like he was just "Peter's brother." The gospel hardly ever mention Andrew apart from Peter. There is one major exception. In John's Gospel, Andrew is said to be a disciple of John the Baptist. One day Jesus happened to walk by. John said to Andrew and another disciple, "Look, there is the Lamb of God." So Andrew and the other disciple began following Jesus.

Andrew must have gone home and told his brother Peter. Soon after, Jesus came to the seashore and invited both Peter and Andrew to leave their fishing nets and come follow him. In any case, we can thank Andrew for introducing Peter to Jesus.

But there was a price to pay. In calling the brothers to follow him,

Jesus was asking them to leave behind the only life they knew. Something about Jesus captivated the two brothers. Both ended up giving their lives for him. What am I willing to leave behind in order to be a disciple of Jesus?
