First Reading: Isa. 50:4-7 The suffering servant was persecuted and struck by his own people; he was spit upon and beaten. He proclaims the true faith and suffers to atone for the sins of his people. Here we see a foreshadowing of the true servant of God.

Second Reading: Phil. 2:6-11 Paul urges us to humility, by which we are made like Christ our Lord. He put off the majesty of his divinity and became man and humbled himself in obedience to an ignominious death on the cross.

Gospel: Mk. 14:1-165, 47 or 15:1-39 Mark recounts the events that led up to the betrayal of Jesus and his final condemnation—his death on the cross. At the Last Supper, Jesus gives us the Holy Eucharist.
